- Be a practising Catholic and fully supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic Education

- Understand the importance of developing positive relationships with children, staff and parents and can demonstrate evidence of such actions.
- A comprehensive knowledge of the West Australian Curriculum with the ability to organise, select and design content for effective teaching and differentiated learning.
- Evidence of early childhood pedagogy and understanding of NQS and the EYLF.
- Demonstrate excellent classroom management and organisational skills that create a supportive and safe environment.
