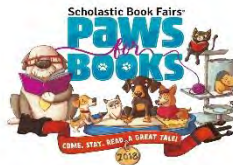
Year 4 First Eucharist

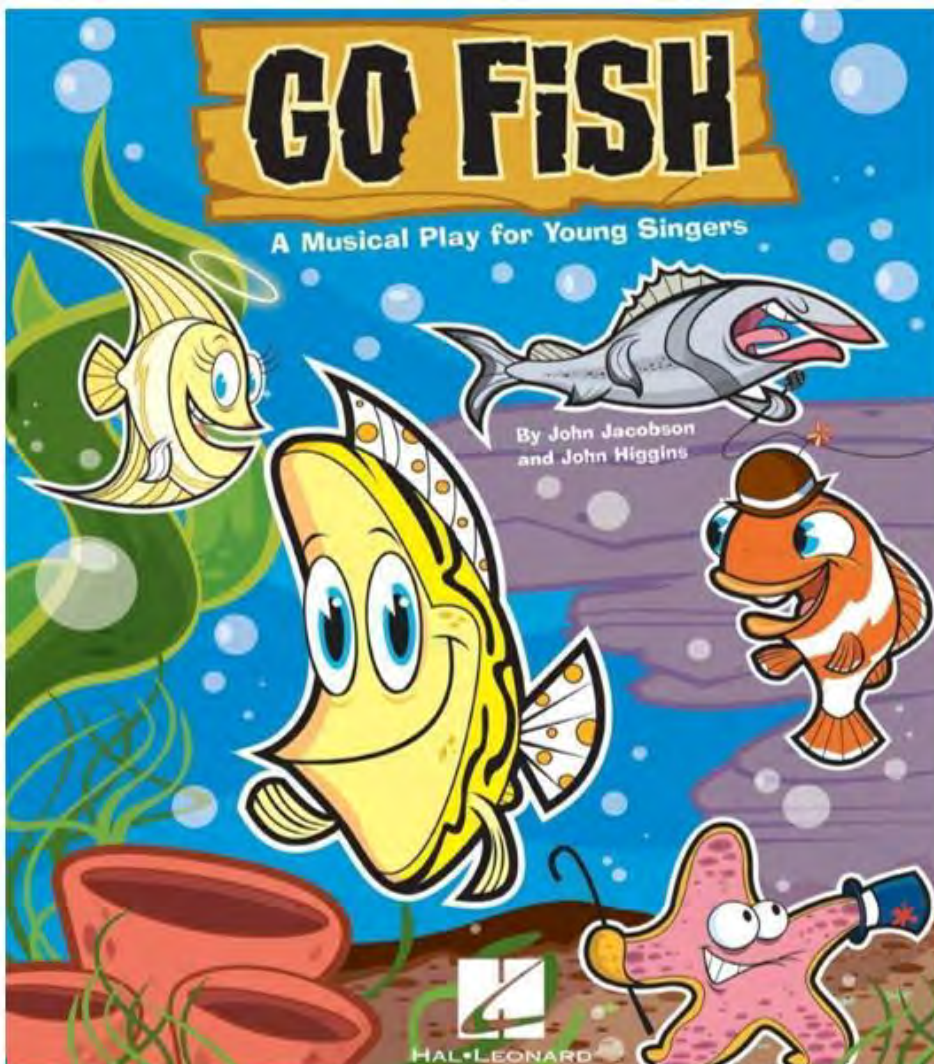
